Project Title - "THE LIQUID FOREST"

The project consists of a cast glass wall inside a lit reflecting pond at the Kona Kai Resort in San Diego. The wall of cast glass will have a graceful kelp bed moving through it from left to right along its thirty two panels. There will be schools of fish and sea turtles moving gracefully throughout the entire kelp forest. Each panel will measure approximately four feet wide by seven feet tall at its highest point. The entire wall will measure sixty four feet in length. The project will be divided into two sections with a walk way going through its center directing foot traffic into the entryway of the spa. The top edge of the glass will be water jet cut and then etched out to detail the surface of the ocean. There will be a smaller layer of blue glass offset and running in front of and parallel to the wall itself. The blue glass will have a wave like texture etched and cast into it. The piece is intended to represent our city's connection to the ocean which lies just outside the harbor entrance where the project is located.
